Encodability View and Detectability Confidence History Files

To download the Encodability View or Detectability Confidence history files the following steps must be completed:

- 1. Verify the computer is connected to your LAN and the MCEM via the rear panel ethernet port.
- 2. Identify the MCEM's IP address. This can be found via the front panel LCD display. From the front panel, press the top arrow 3 times.
- 3. Open a web browser (Microsoft Internet Explorer[®], Firefox[®], Chrome[™], Opera[®], or Safari[®]) on the computer connected to the monitor and enter the following in the address window: https://IP-address
- 4. The login window will open. Enter the user name, **Station** (case-sensitive), and the password, **COlumb1aMD** (case-sensitive), and click the OK button.
- 5. Navigate to the menu item (Encodability View or Detectability Confidence).
- 6. At the bottom of the page click on the link to download.
- 7. A prompt will appear to save the zip file.
- 8. The file can be opened with Excel, Google Sheets, or other spreadsheet program.


